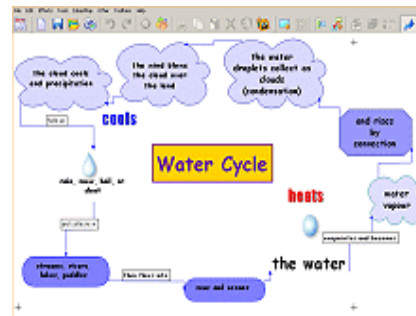
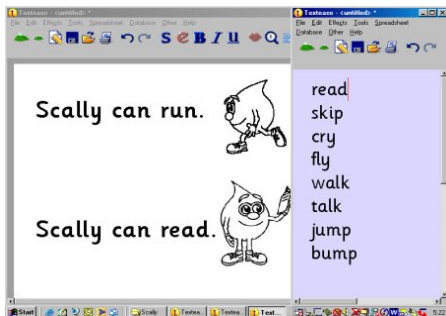


TEXTEASE - a practical session with a powerful talking word processor
